

Member Submission Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in submitting your writing to CASE! Below are guidelines that will assist you in ensuring your piece is ready for publishing and meets the requirements set out by our team.

1. Topic

1.1. Topics must relate to:

1.1.1. Consent, in all forms, *or*

1.1.2. Sexualized Assault, *or*

1.1.3. Sexualized Harassment, *or*

1.1.4. Prevention thereof

2. Length

2.1. There is no finite length requirement, however submissions should try to stay under the 1,500 word mark.

2.2. Academic papers will not be accepted.

2.3. Submissions should be personal in nature, though names and identifying details may be changed

3. Editing

3.1. Unfortunately, editing services are not available at this point in time.

4. Inclusivity

4.1. Submissions should reflect an intersectional feminist perspective.

4.2. Articles that are: transphobic, racist, misogynistic, ableist, homophobic, anti-choice, fatphobic, slut-shaming, sex-shaming, victim-blaming, rape apologetic, or sex-worker exclusive of any kind will not be accepted.

4.3. Please try to use gender-neutral terms where possible.

4.3.1. Example: Instead of “pregnant women” use “pregnant people”.

5. Tone

5.1. No specific tone is required.
